Antidumping and Countervailing Duty Investigations on Wooden Cabinets and Vanities for Permanent Installation from China

Dear Valued Customer,

On March 6, 2019, The American Kitchen Cabinet Alliance filed antidumping and countervailing petitions with the U.S. Department of Commerce (DOC) and the U.S. International Trade Commission (ITC), asserting that certain wooden cabinets and vanities for permanent installation from China are being sold at less than normal value.

The list of goods covered by these petitions is extensive and includes cabinets and vanities made substantially of wood products, including solid wood and engineered wood products. The latter includes those constructed of wood particles, fibers, plywood, strand board, block board, particle board, fiberboard, or bamboo. As they serve the purpose and function of permanently installed or affixed cabinetry, wooden cabinets and vanities with or without the following could also be affected by these petitions:

- Wood veneers, wood, paper, or other overlays or laminates
- Non-wood components or trim such as metal, marble, glass, plastic, or other resins
- Finished or unfinished surfaces

- Assembled or completed and not assembled or completed

- **April 22, 2019:** ITC Preliminary Determination
- **May 30, 2019:** DOC Preliminary Determination on Countervailing Duty (CVD), unless postponed.
- **August 13, 2019:** DOC Preliminary Determination on Antidumping Duty (ADD), unless postponed.
